We will need to remain outside the country up to 90 days or until the visas are approved. We're currently planning to use this time for visits to some of the missionary teams that we serve here in Europe! Please ask God to order our steps and to help us have listening ears and hearts as we spend time with our missionary workers.

Almost daily we are reminded of your faithfulness to us through prayer and giving! Your commitment to us and this important ministry make it possible for us to continue to forge ahead in providing member care for our people. While we wouldn't choose this unpredictable timetable in these coming months, our hope continues strongly in the Lord! He has never failed us and we know He never will.
